ST PAUL AG SOCIETY 2021 RODEO PARADE CATEGORIES

Note - "NO THROWING OF CANDY" WILL BE STRICKLY ENFORCED THIS YEAR. WALKERS MUST BE USED!

When you arrive to line up for the parade you will be placed in line depending on the entry size only. We will not be separating the floats by category as we have in past years. Large equipment, trucks with trailers etc will be asked to stay along the Iron Horse Trail. Smaller vehicles, etc. will be asked to go into the soccer field parking area (through what is normally the exit road) and line up in that area. Parade volunteers will be on hand to instruct you where to line up.

All entries must be registered!

COMMERCIAL FLOATS

-Businesses and Companies. Businesses that are for-profit such as retail or sale of services.

CLUB FLOATS

- Non-profit organizations or groups. These include cultural/ethnic groups, church organizations, municipalities, or groups united for a common purpose, such as youth or senior groups.
- ➤ THEME FLOATS "Celebrating Hometown Businesses and Farming Communities" -Entries include all floats that decorate to the theme. They may/can include floats from any of the categories; Commercial, Club or Horse Entries. One prize will be handed out to the best float in this category.

HORSE ENTRIES

-Entries where horses are being driven, pulling a buggy or wagon or are being ridden. This includes individual and riding groups.

ANTIQUES

-Includes cars, trucks, tractors that are older than 25 years old.

MOTORIZED


-This includes vehicles, tractors, equipment or anything motorized but not considered antique.

> INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES

-This category is for anyone who wants to have fun in the parade.

Parade Route

(3.2 kms... 2 miles)



Return Route:

Extra Large Vehicles – Do not turn south at Landing Pad, end parade by driving past the pad.

All Others – Turn south at Landing Pad and proceed to 48 ave. A parade volunteer will tell you which road to use to get back.

Horse Drawn Entries – Turn right into Rec Grounds and continue around buildings to make your way back to the Iron Horse Trail.

RULES & REGULATIONS

The St Paul AG Society and St Paul & District Chamber of Commerce strives to ensure a safe and fun environment for all participants and the audience. Please read these rules and regulations carefully for the benefit of parade participants, spectators and AG member volunteers.

- **INDEMNIFICATION**: The parade participant and their entourage, shall indemnify, defend and save harmless the St Paul Agricultural Society and the Town of St Paul from and against any and all claims, losses, costs, expenses, damages and liabilities due to bodily injury or property damage arising directly or indirectly from his or her participation in the parade.
- **DECORATIONS** Entries must be decorated! Murals, wrapped vehicles, details and custom paint jobs may be incorporated but are not considered decorated.
- **FLOAT DIMENSIONS** All parade entries will not exceed the maximum allowed by the Traffic Safety Act. In all cases, float dimensions must be able to safely negotiate the eight (8) 90° turns required along the parade route. Height 4.15 m (13.5 feet) / Length 12.5 m (41 feet) / Width 2.6 m (8.5 feet)
- DRIVERS <u>Must have read and be aware of the information in this manual</u>. All drivers will have a
 valid driver's license. Drivers need to ensure all aspects of their float is in good working order. Drivers
 must have a 180° view from their position at all times and not be distracted by doing anything other
 than driving.
- **LIVESTOCK** All livestock entries must display a proper disposition and be in control without assistance at all times. Livestock should be 'parade-wise', well-groomed, healthy and in good condition to complete the parade route.
- CANDY DISTRIBUTION: For the safety of both parade watchers and parade participant's candy and
 other materials <u>CANNOT BE THROWN</u> from moving vehicles. Entries must use walkers to distribute
 along the sides of the parade route. These walkers must keep pace with their float. The St Paul AG
 Society <u>discourages</u> the distribution of candy and other such items.
- PARADE ASSEMBLY: Parade assembles at the St Paul Soccer Fields on 53 Ave. To alleviate traffic on 53 Ave, all parade entries should arrive on the Iron Horse Trail eastbound from 46 St (through parking lot of Optigrow (formerly Martin's Landscaping). The area for unloading horses is adjacent to the Iron Horse Trail (53 Ave) between 46 & 48 streets. Assembly starts at 7:00 am.
- MUSIC: Entries are encouraged to incorporate music (but kept to a reasonable level)
- PARADE POSITION: Will be assigned at the discretion of the parade volunteers upon departure of parade.
- **DISTANCE BETWEEN FLOATS** Drivers please keep <u>18' between floats.</u> If you are closer people cannot see the entire float in front of you. Further away and the parade starts to get broken up and lag behind. Please keep proper pace with the float in front of you.
- ENTRY FORM: All entries must be duly completed, signed and received before 4:00 Tuesday, August 31st. 2021
