RULES & REGULATIONS

All entries must be registered!

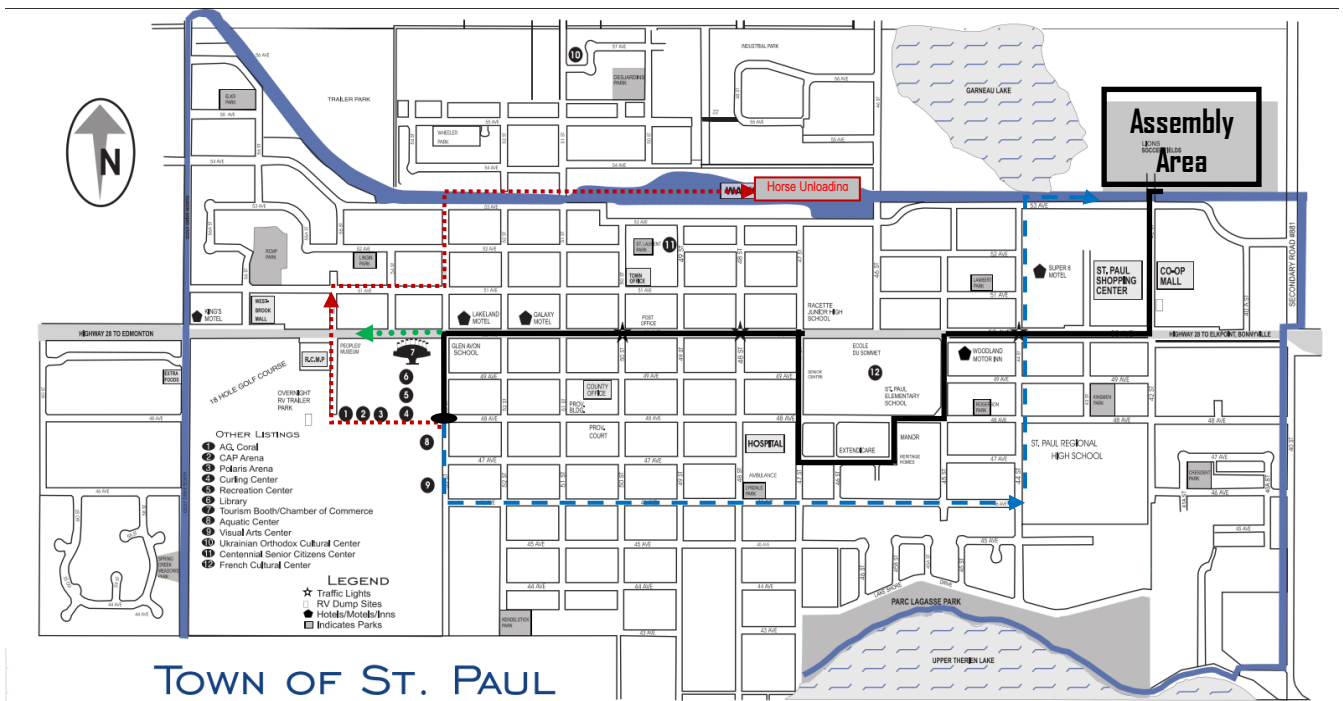
The St Paul AG Society strives to ensure a safe and fun environment for all participants and the audience. Please read these rules and regulations carefully for the benefit of parade participants, spectators and AG member volunteers.

- **INDEMNIFICATION:** The parade participant and their entourage, shall indemnify, defend and save harmless the St Paul Agricultural Society and the Town of St Paul from and against any and all claims, losses, costs, expenses, damages and liabilities due to bodily injury or property damage arising directly or indirectly from his or her participation in the parade.
- **DECORATIONS:** Please decorate your entry. Murals, wrapped vehicles, details and custom paint jobs may be incorporated but are not considered decorated.
- **FLOAT DIMENSIONS:** All parade entries will not exceed the maximum allowed by the Traffic Safety Act. In all cases, float dimensions must be able to safely negotiate the eight (8) - 90° turns required along the parade route. Height – 4.15 m (13.5 ft) / Length – 12.5 m (41 ft) / Width – 2.6 m (8.5 ft).
- **DRIVERS:** Must have read and be aware of the information in this manual. All drivers will have a valid driver's license. Drivers need to ensure all aspects of their float is in good working order. Drivers must have a 180° view from their position at all times and not be distracted by doing anything other than driving.
- **LIVESTOCK:** All livestock entries must display a proper disposition and be in control without assistance at all times. Livestock should be 'parade-wise', well-groomed, healthy and in good condition to complete the parade route.
- **CANDY DISTRIBUTION:** For the safety of both parade watchers and parade participants, candy and other materials **CANNOT BE THROWN** from moving vehicles. **Please use walkers to distribute along the sides of the parade route.** Walkers must be able to keep pace with their float. The 2021 parade saw the maximum participation of distributed candy and for that the St. Paul Ag Society thanks you very much. Let's keep it going!
- **PARADE ASSEMBLY:** Parade assembles at the St. Paul Soccer Fields on 53 Ave. To alleviate traffic on 53 Ave, all parade entries should arrive on the Iron Horse Trail eastbound from 46 St (**through parking lot of the former Martin's Landscaping**). The area for unloading horses is adjacent to the Iron Horse Trail (53 Ave) between 46 & 48 streets. **Assembly starts as of 7:00 am.**
- **MUSIC:** Entries are encouraged to incorporate music (we ask that it be kept to a reasonable level within the staging area – thank you for your cooperation).
- **PARADE POSITION:** Will be assigned at the discretion of the parade volunteers upon departure of parade.
- **PARADE ROUTE:** The parade route is 3.2 kms (2 miles) from start to finish. Please ensure walkers are fit and in comfortable walking shoes to ensure an enjoyable experience.
- **DISTANCE BETWEEN FLOATS:** Attention Drivers – please keep 18' between floats. If you are closer people cannot see the entire float in front of you. Further away and the parade starts to get broken up and lag behind. Please keep proper pace with the float in front of you.
- **ENTRY FORM:** All entries must be duly completed, signed and received by 4:00 pm Thursday, August 31st. 2023

ST. PAUL AG SOCIETY 2023 RODEO PARADE

Note - There will not be any judging this year therefore there is no need to separate into categories. When you arrive to line up for the parade you will be placed in line depending on the size of your entry. We will be separating floats by size. Large equipment, trucks with trailers etc. will be asked to stay along the Iron Horse Trail. Smaller vehicles, floats, etc. will enter into the soccer field parking area through the exit road and line up in that area. Parade volunteers will be on hand to instruct you where to line up.

Parade Route (3.2 kms... 2 miles)



Return Route:

Extra Large Vehicles – End parade by driving past the pad, do not turn left at pad.▶

Others – Turn south at pad to 48 ave. A parade volunteer will direct you from there. ---▶

Horse/s-Drawn entries – Enter the Rec Grounds and continue around buildings to head back north to make your back to the Iron Horse Trail. Please stay off the paved walking trail. Thank you.▶
